Project Delivery

- Take ownership of the Project Management activities of the NPI process with support from the development team, identifying best practice DFM/DFA techniques and characteristics where necessary.
- Provide inputs to the Quality team in advising and directing suppliers on the most appropriate validation methods. Write, review and approve manufacturing specifications, test protocols and reports.
- Creation & management of the PFMEA process.

Supplier Management
